

Ling & Schandorff to race VSR Lambo in GT Open

Kang Ling and Frederik Schandorff will race for VSR in this season's International GT Open Championship which kicks off next week at Paul Ricard.



The VSR Lamborghini GT3 Huracan will be driven by China's Kang Ling and Frederik Schandorff from Denmark in this year's GT Open. Ling raced with the team last year in the Pro category and this season is also taking part in the Italian GT Endurance Championship. Schandorff comes from Super Trofeo and this season will be his first year racing GT3 machinery. The team made it's European GT3 racing debut in 2018, winning the International GT Open Am Championship.
