VSR and Lamborghini to return to Fanatec GT World Challenge Asia

VSR will return to Asia in 2024 with two Lamborghini Huracán GT3 Evo 2 cars confirmed for the 2024 Fanatec GT World Challenge Asia. The driver line-up for one car is confirmed and will see the 2023 Am Champion Bian Ye from China pair up with Italian Edoardo Liberati. The drivers for the second car are still to be decided.

VSR raced successfully in Asia before the Covid-19 pandemic, winning the Am Championship in 2017 and finishing 3rd in Pro-Am in 2019. In the intervening years the Italian based team has picked up the International GT Open and Italian GT Sprint and Endurance Championships.

Vincenzo Sospiri (VSR Team Principal): I'm very proud to be returning to Asia with the support of Lamborghini Squadra Corse and am thrilled to welcome Bian to the VSR family. I am sure he and Edoardo will make a competitive pairing and look forward to announcing a strong line-up for the sister car shortly.
